Web-Based Training (WBT)

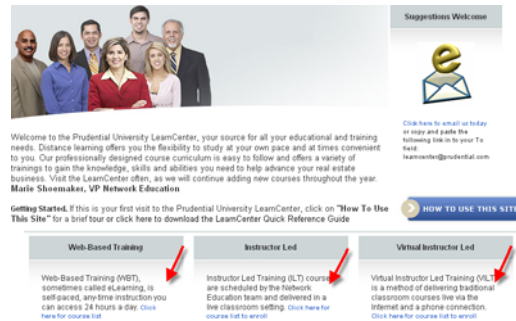
WBT, sometimes called eLearning, is self-paced, any-time instruction you can access 24 hours a day.

To activate a self-paced course, click on the link, "Click here for course list" in the Web-Based Training column on the home page of LearnCenter. Find the course and click on the link "Click here to start this course."

Instructor Led Training (ILT)

ILT courses are scheduled by the Network Education team and delivered in a live classroom setting.

To enroll in an Instructor Led session, click on the link, "Click here for course list" in the Instructor Led Training column on the home page of LearnCenter. Click on the name of the session in the Enrollment Name column. At the course description page, click on the "Enroll" button.



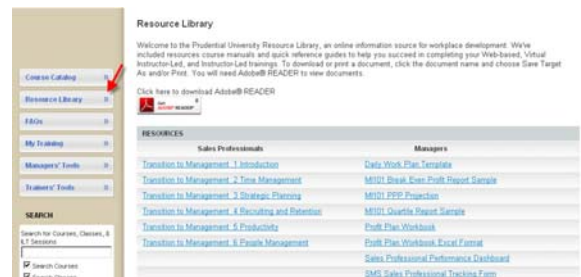
Virtual Instructor Led Training (VILT)

VILT is a method of delivering traditional classroom courses live via the Internet and a phone connection.

To enroll in a Virtual Instructor Led session, click on the link, "Click here for course list" in the Virtual Instructor Led column on the home page of LearnCenter. Click on the name of the session in the VILT Enrollment Name column. At the session description page, click on the "Enroll" button.

Resource Library

To download materials from the Resource Library, click "Resource Library" in the left navigation. Once at the Resource Library, click the name of the document you wish to download. Once the document appears, you can save it to your computer or print by selecting the print icon.
